

Cockburn Events Colouring Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. Eligibility

- Entry to the competition is free and open to children aged **3–12 years** who live in the **City of Cockburn**.
- Entries will be assessed in two age categories:
 - **Ages 3–6**
 - **Ages 7–12**
- Entries must be submitted by a **parent or legal guardian** on behalf of the child.
- City of Cockburn employees, Elected Members, and their immediate families are ineligible to enter.

2. Competition period

- The competition opens at **9:00am on Friday 23 January 2026**.
- The competition closes at **4:00pm on Friday 27 February 2026**.
- Entries received after the closing date will not be accepted.

3. How to enter

- To enter, participants must:
 - Complete the official colouring-in page; and
 - Submit a photo or scan of the completed entry via the online form at **comment.cockburn.wa.gov.au** (or via the QR code provided).
- One entry per child is permitted.
- Entries must be the original work of the child.

4. Judging

- Entries with the greatest number of upvotes in each category will be deemed the winner.
 - **How upvoting works**
Once entries are approved by the City of Cockburn, they will be published to



the online gallery within the Social Pinpoint Gather tool. Members of the public will be able to view the entries and cast an upvote for their favourite artwork.

- **Who can upvote**

Upvoting is open to the general public. Each user may only upvote an individual entry once. The City reserves the right to monitor and remove votes that are identified as fraudulent, automated, or in breach of the platform's usage conditions.

- **Where entries will be displayed**

All eligible entries will be displayed in an online gallery hosted on the City of Cockburn's Social Pinpoint Gather platform for the duration of the voting period.

- **Determining the winner**

The entry in each age category that receives the highest number of valid upvotes at the close of the voting period will be declared the winner.

- **Tie-break process**

In the event of a tie within an age category, the tied entries will be reviewed by a panel of City of Cockburn staff, who will select the winning entry based on creativity and overall presentation. The panel's decision will be final.

5. Prizes

- There will be **one winner per age category**.
- Each winner will receive **one Adventure World Family Pass**, valid for:
 - **2 Adults (14+ years) and 2 Children (4–13 years)**, or
 - **1 Adult (14+ years) and 3 Children (4–13 years)**.
- The prize **expires on 19 April 2026**.
- Prizes are not transferable or redeemable for cash.

6. Winner notification

- Winners will be notified by email using the contact details provided at the time of entry.
- If a winner does not respond within **14 days**, the City of Cockburn reserves the right to award the prize to another entrant.



7. Rights and use of entries

- By entering, participants grant the City of Cockburn permission to use submitted entries for **promotional and reporting purposes**, including on the City's website and social media channels.
- The City may use the child's **first name and age** when publishing entries.
- The City reserves the right to disqualify any entry that is not in accordance with these terms and conditions or who has, in the opinion of the City, engaged in conduct in entering the draw which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or generally damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the City and spirit of the campaign. The City reserves the right to disqualify a winner without warning or notice if the City becomes aware that the winner and/or the winner's entry is of a type described in this clause.

8. Privacy

- Personal information collected will be used solely for the purpose of administering the competition and in accordance with the City of Cockburn's Privacy Policy.

9. General

- The City of Cockburn reserves the right to cancel, modify or suspend the competition if required.
